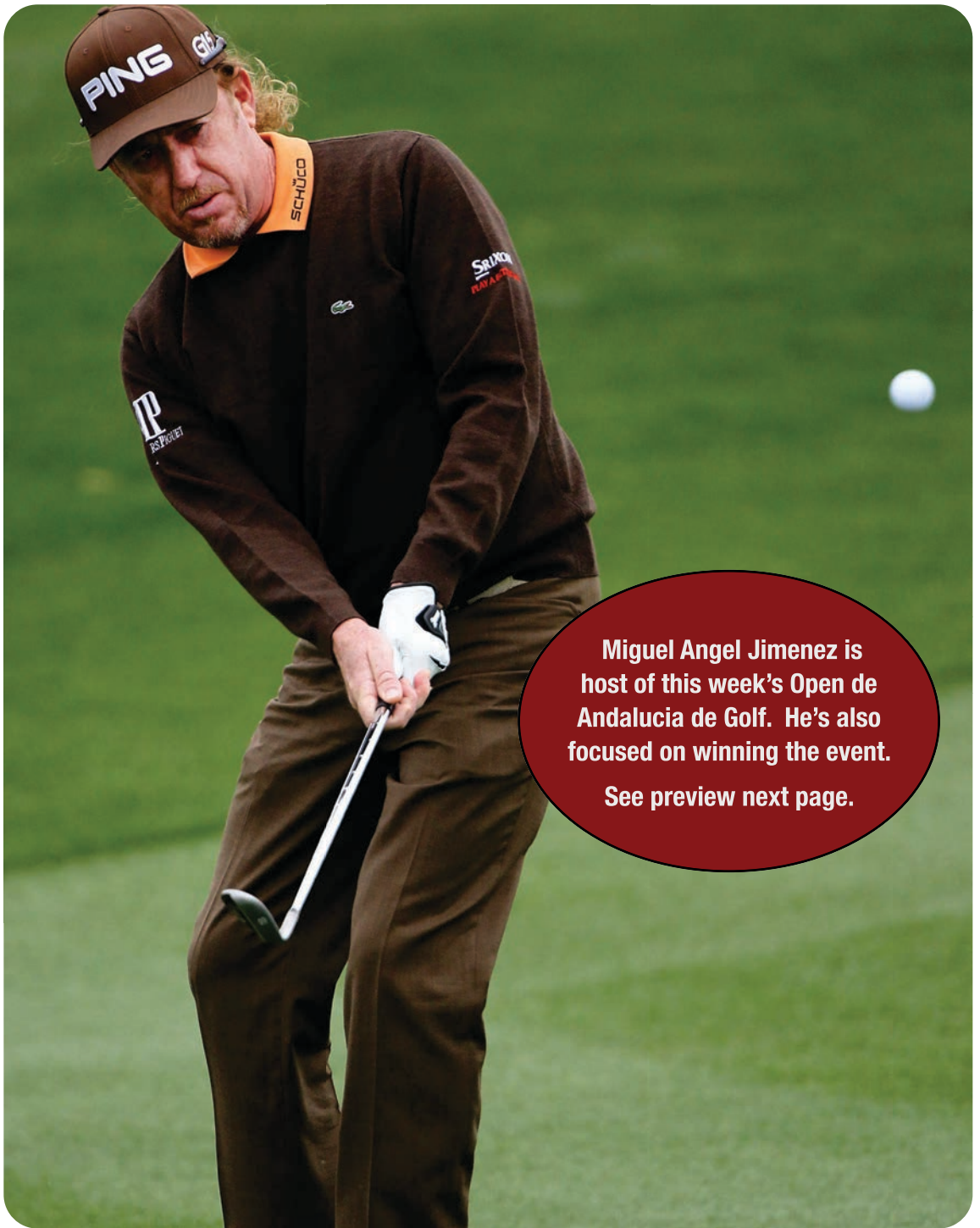

The event is hosted by a company owned by Jimenez, himself a past winner of the event. He said being

tournament host is rewarding because it promotes golf and tourism in Andalucia, and gives back to the game that he loves. "I am what I am thanks to golf," he said. But hosting has its challenges. "My mind tends to be all over the place. It's a relief when you get onto the first tee and can focus on your game."
