His rounds of 67-64-68-68 put him at 21-under. Triplett made 23 birdies for the week and played his final 60 holes bogey-free.

## G20 driver and Anser Milled putter earn first tour victories

With his G20, Calc was T1 in average driving distance at 307.8.
