## SEASON OF SUCCESS

In the PGA Tour season that ended Monday, PING earned seven staff wins, had 10 driver victories, and a record eight players advanced to the Tour Championship, where PING products led tee to green and on the green (see box at left).

First-time winners on the PGA Tour included Joaquín Niemann, Sebastian Muñoz, Rookie of the Year contender Viktor Hovland, and Tyrrell Hatton. Andrew Landry, Michael Thompson and Cameron Champ picked up their second wins. Fifteen staffers qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs.

PING was the #1 driver brand at three tournaments, including for the first time at a WGC event.

With a win and five more top 10s, Tyrrell Hatton finished 7<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup, highest among PING pros.
