PROS POST HIGH FINISHES

Miguel Angel Jiménez earned a runner-up at the Constellation Furyk & Friends, continuing his stellar PGA Tour Champions season. The 57-year-old has two wins among 14 top 10s. In his past three Champions events he’s finished second, T4, and was second at The Senior Open Championship.

On the LPGA Tour, Caroline Masson finished second, her best result this season, and Elizabeth Szokol was third at the Cognizant Founders Cup. Masson made seven birdies in a bogey-free 64 Sunday, low round of the day. It was the third top 10 this season for the up-and-coming Szokol.
